INTERIOR DESIGN & ELECTROLUX ICON® KITCHEN DESIGN COMPETITION OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES

1. Eligibility. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. Subject to the additional limitations below, the Interior Design and Electrolux Kitchen Design Competition (the "Contest") is open only to legal residents of the continental United States, who at the time of entry are at least of majority age in their state of residence (19 in Alabama and Nebraska, 21 in Mississippi; 18 in all other states and the District of Columbia) and who are practicing architects or designers or students earning a degree in architecture or design. Employees of Sandow Media, LLC, ("Sponsor"), Electrolux Home Products, Inc ("Electrolux"), and the employees of each of their respective affiliated companies, subsidiaries, advertising or promotional agencies, and other agents, involved with this contest and the immediate family members of, and any persons domiciled with, any such employees, are not eligible to enter or win. For purposes of the Contest, "immediate family members" means a participant's spouse, children, siblings, grand parents and grand children. Contest is void in ALASKA AND HAWAII and where prohibited by law and is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws.

2. How to Enter and Participate. The Contest will begin at 12:01 a.m. [Eastern Daylight Savings Time] on March 29, 2011 and all entries must be received at the address specified in the Official Entry Form by 5:00 p.m. [Eastern Daylight Savings Time] on October 17, 2011 (the "Contest Period"). To enter, fill out the Official Entry Form published in Interior Design magazine or available at www.InteriorDesign.net and send it to the specified address, together with all required materials complying with all of the specifications in the accompanying "Call for Entries," for receipt during the Contest Period. Multiple entries are permitted, although a participant is only eligible to receive a single prize. Sponsor will not be responsible for incomplete, lost, late, misdirected, postage due, mutilated or illegible entries. Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify any entries by persons determined to be tampering with or abusing any aspect of the Contest. All entries become the property of Sponsor and will not be acknowledged or returned.

3. Entry Requirements and Judging. All submissions must include: a concept description of the kitchen (250 words [max], list of materials and sources, model numbers of Electrolux ICON® appliances used, floor plan with dimensions and elevations, a minimum of three 8.5"x11" view points of the kitchen, all renderings should also be included on a CD in high resolution tiff/jpeg format, complete entry form signed by applicant and all materials labeled on back with designer/firm name. Additional requirements for entry are as follows: rendering must include a minimum of five Electrolux ICON® appliances and the entry must be exclusive to this competition and may not have been or be submitted to other contests. The entries will be judged by an esteemed panel of judges based equally on the following criteria: how thoughtfully and boldly the kitchen is designed, visual appeal, creativity, elements and principals of kitchen design and innovative integration of appliances.

4. Prizes. A total of three prizes (the "Prizes") will be awarded, as detailed in the accompanying "Call for Entries." The Prize winners will be selected by a panel of judges, as described in the "Call for Entries," provided that Sponsor reserves the right to modify the constitution of such panel in its sole discretion. The estimated retail value of the 1st Place Prize is U.S. \$45,000 (\$20,000 in cash, approximately \$15,000 worth of appliances & \$10,000 worth of cabinetry). The estimated retail value of the 2nd Place Prize is U.S. \$10,000 (approximately \$10,000 worth of appliances). The estimated retail value of the 3rd Place Prize is U.S. \$5,000 (approximately \$5,000 worth of appliances). Electrolux will only fulfill the prize in the continental United States, including Washington DC (the "Territory"). Prizes do not include installation. Winners will be solely responsible for all installation costs and removal of old appliances, except where prohibited by law. Selection of appliances will be made by the Prize Winners up to the maximum retail values set forth above.

Any such permitted use of the Material shall bear a notice that it is utilized with the permission of Electrolux.
